Provide additional open space where feasible in gap areas so that people are within easy walking distance of open space.					
Improve the design of open spaces and the pedestrian amenity in the local street network near gap areas to improve open space quality and accessibility.					
Establish a fair and equitable open space contribution framework for the forecast population. This will include monetary contributions toward facilities in open space and/or land contributions as appropriate.					
Encourage physical activity and fitness by increasing the diversity of structured sport and recreation facilities.					
Encourage physical activity and fitness by increasing the diversity of informal recreation facilities to appeal to all age groups and people of all abilities.					
Recognise the importance of places for people to relax and unwind in open space and balance the provision of contemplative spaces with facilities that encourage activity.					
Continue to improve linear open space connectivity to improve biodiversity and recreational values, including along waterways and the Outer Circle Linear Park.					
Continue to protect remnant indigenous trees including encouraging regeneration of indigenous trees in open space.					
Continue to encourage use of indigenous vegetation in existing and new open space.					
Continue to investigate and implement sustainable water use in open space.					
Protect large canopy shade trees and increase planting where appropriate in open space, along with maximising permeable surfaces including garden beds and grassed areas to provide cool spaces during hot summers.					
Recognise and protect indigenous heritage values of open space. Prepare Cultural Heritage Management Plans where appropriate, prior to any future works in areas with potential cultural sensitivity.					
Recognise and protect the non-indigenous historical values of open space with the preparation of Conservation Management Plans where appropriate to guide future works.					
Upgrade a range of existing open spaces in accordance with priorities outlined in the Draft Strategy for both the existing and forecast population.

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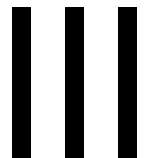
