

"But I'm stuck at home!" I hear you cry. "How can I go on a quest with my friends?"


Fear not, brave adventurer! You don't need to leave your house to explore fantastic worlds with your favourite companions.

Create a superhero

Can you create a superhero of your own?

- 1. Pick an ordinary object that you can see around the house.
- 2. Imagine that it is the main weapon of a superhero. How might it be used? Could it be used for self-defence, or attack or to move from one place to another?
- 3. Start creating the character who uses this item. What is their name?

Here is an example: Eggbeater Man... he fights bad eggs.

Share your superhero by writing a page about them, drawing and labelling a picture, or creating and photographing.

Design your very own treehouse


Let your imagination run wild!

- Cardboard tubes (toilet roll and paper towel) empty cardboard boxes
- Coloured paper
- Objects such as cotton reels, matchboxes, fabrics, plasticine, things from nature such as leaves and sticks

Create a new animal


Put your thinking cap on, tap into your imagination and create a new animal.
