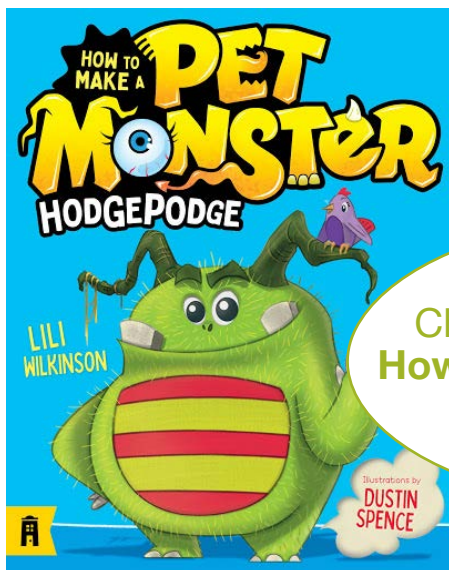
Rainbow reading

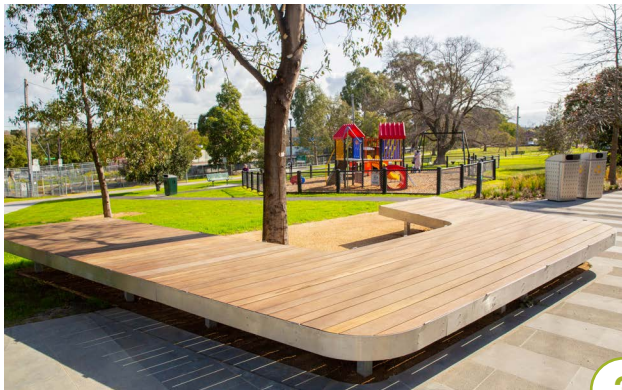

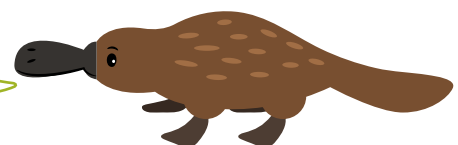

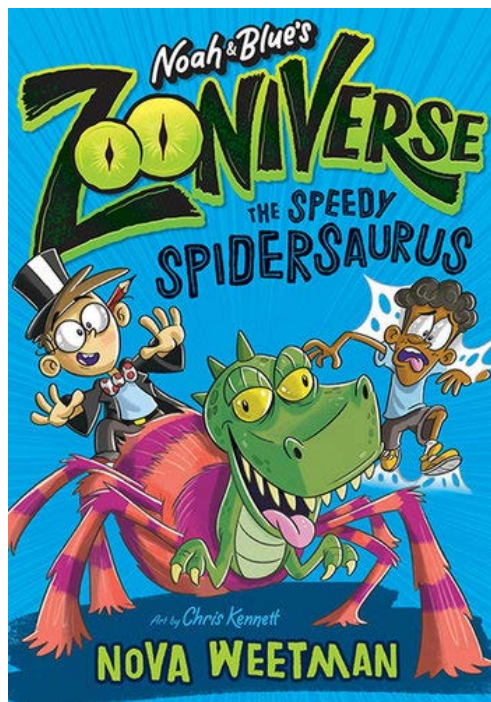


Animal Mash Up

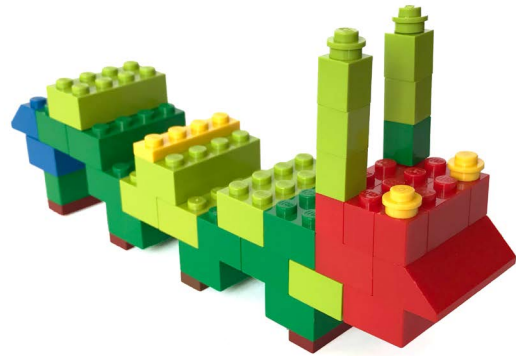
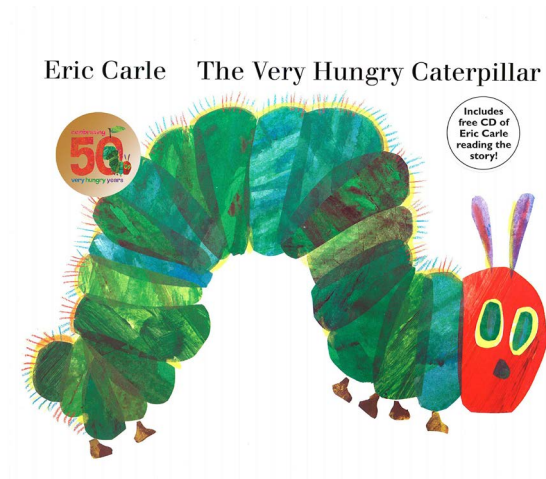
