# 7.1 Contract 2021/002 General Landscape Services and Supplies

## **Abstract**

This report seeks Council endorsement for the award of Contract No. 2021/002, General Landscape Supply and Associated Services - Panel of Contractors. This contract will establish a new panel of contractors to provide a variety of general landscape services, mulching and under surfacing and delivery of landscape materials, for an initial term of three (3) years with two (2) possible extensions of one (1) year each to a maximum contract term of five (5) years.

This is a replacement of existing contracts which have reached the end of their maximum term.

The estimated contract cost for the maximum contract term is \$5,874,000 (including GST), and excluding any price adjustment due to rise and fall. The estimated cost to Council after the return of the GST Tax Input Credits is \$5,340,000. Because of the value of the contract it was publicly advertised in accordance with the requirements of section 186 of the *Local Government Act.1989*.

Confidential information is contained in **Attachment 1**, as circulated in the confidential section of the agenda attachments, in accordance with Section 66(2)(a) and the definitions of 'confidential information' in Section 3(1) of the Local Government Act 2020. The information relates to private commercial information, being information provided by a business or commercial undertaking that if released, would unreasonably expose the business or commercial undertaking to disadvantage. The item has been included in the public agenda to facilitate transparency and accountability in Council's decision making.

# 1. Purpose

The purpose of this report is for Council to give consideration to the awarding of Contract No. 2021/002, General Landscape Supply and Associated Services - Panel of Contractors.

## 2. Policy implications and relevance to community plan and council plan

This contract aligns with the following themes and strategies in the Boroondara Community Plan (2017 -27) and Council Plan (2017- 21):

- Theme Two "Your Parks and Green Spaces"
  - Strategy 1.1 Plan, maintain and renew multi-purpose facilities & sprots precincts to meet broad, intergenerational needs of community now & into the future,
  - Strategy 2.1 Sustainably design, manage and utilise parks and green spaces to foster a connected and healthy community for all ages and abilities, and
  - Strategy 2.5 Increase and improve public amenities and facilities in open spaces to enhance functionality for a wider range of uses.

This procurement process has been carried out in accordance with the requirements of Council's Contracts and Tendering Probity Policy and Council's Procurement Policy

## 3. Background

Council requires an arrangement of three panels of suitably qualified and experienced contractors to provide a variety of general landscape services, mulching and under surfacing and delivery of landscape materials in accordance with the requirements of the specification.

#### Invitation to tender

In accordance with Council's procurement procedures and Section 186 of the *Local Government Act 1989*, Council invited public tenders from suitably qualified organisations to undertake Council's general landscape supply and associated services. An invitation to tender was advertised in the local government tenders section of "The Age" newspaper on Saturday 30 January 2021 and on Council's website. The closing date for submissions was 4pm, Friday 26 February 2021.

In response to the advertisement, Council received 13 submissions:

## 4. Outline of key issues/options

There are no issues regarding this procurement.

This proposed contract is important to the ongoing operations of Council and is required to cover a number of key services that cannot be supplied by internal staff. It will also ensure quick procurement of essential supplies and services.

## 5. Consultation/communication

The tender was advertised after extensive consultation within the Waste, Facilities and Infrastructure and Environmental Sustainability and Open Spaces departments who informed the development of the specification and associated tender documents. The procurement process was facilitated by officers from Chief Financial Office, whose participation has ensured transparency and probity.

## 6. Financial and resource implications

Council's 2020-21 September Amended Budget contains a total allocation of \$2,153,753, however only \$1,068,000 is required to be used for the proposed contracted services. The relevant account details are shown in table 6.1.

The contract does not guarantee the appointed contractors a minimum quantity of work in relation to any of the contract components. The services performed will be in accordance with the need and annual budgetary allocations.
