

Notice of decision to abandon amendment Amendment C368boro

On 27 February 2023 Council resolved to abandon Amendment C368boro.

Pursuant to Section 28 of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*, the planning authority (Council) is required to:

- 1. Tell the Minister in writing if it decides to abandon an amendment or part of an amendment.**

The Minister was advised in writing on 28 February 2023.

- 2. Within 10 business days after the day on which the planning authority tells the Minister about its decision, the planning authority must publish a notice of the decision on its Internet site.**

This document constitutes the required notice. This notice will be published on Council's website as soon as practicable.

- 3. This notice must include a statement of reasons for the decision and any other prescribed matter.**

The statement of reasons for the decision are as follows:

- The independent Planning Panel has recommended the amendment be abandoned. While the recommendation to abandon is not consistent with Council's submission to the Panel, officers accept the recommendation as well reasoned. This position was adopted by Council on 27 February 2023.

There are no other prescribed matters.

- 4. This notice must be available on the planning authority's Internet site for a period of at least 2 months.**

This notice will remain on Council's website for a period of at least two months.
